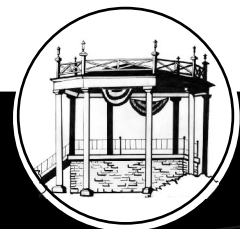
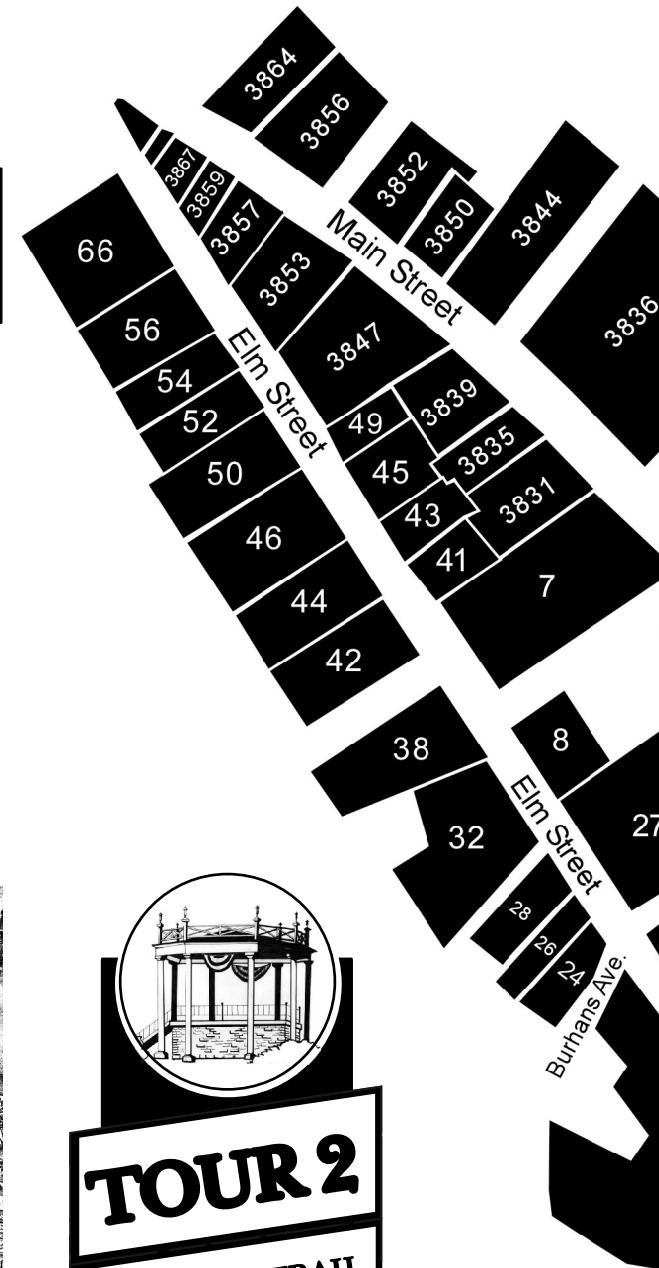
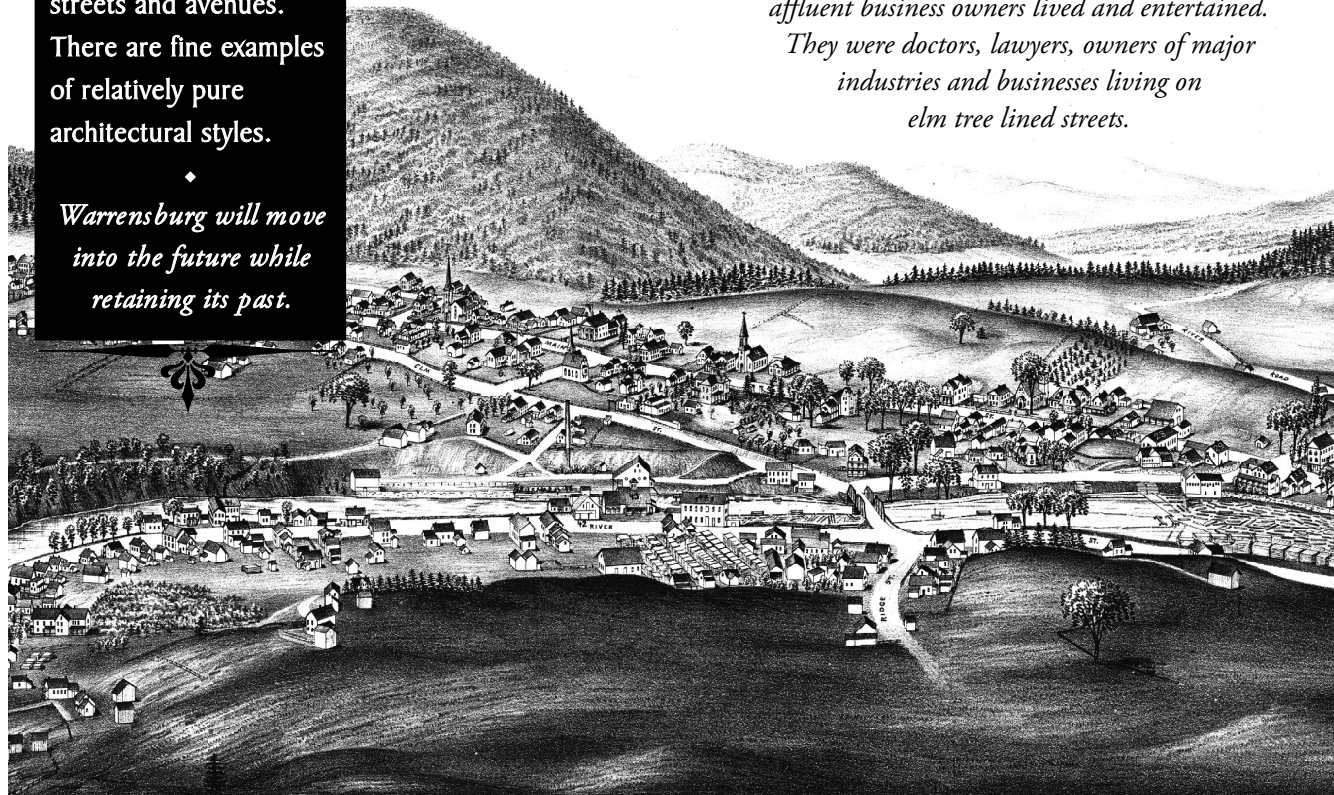
WARRENSBURG HERITAGE TRAIL
